WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department seeks to accept \$100,000 from the Office of Senator Don Perata and compensate Oakland citizens who obtained "One less Gun" gun buy-back vouchers during the gun exchange program in February 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Police Department's allocation of proposed funds will allow Oakland resident voucher holders to receive promised cash for guns; and

WHEREAS, the allocation of said funds will ensure future gun buy-back projects are not jeopardized by the City's inability to produce promised funds; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or her designee, to accept \$100,000 in donated funds to provide compensation and distribute the funds to gun buy-back voucher holders and future program participants; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or her designee, to execute any documents or agreements that may be necessary to implement this resolution.
