RESOLUTION WAIVING CITY'S COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS FOR A SMALL PAY-GO FUNDED PURCHASE IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN THOUSAND FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND THIRTY EIGHT CENTS (\$7,014.38) FOR SIGNAGE TO IMPROVE JOAOUIN MILLER PARK

WHEREAS, a community sign made of kiln-dried red western cedar has been obtained from Strong Signs and provided for the improvement of Joaquin Miller Park; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jean Quan wishes to reimburse this provider out of her pay-go fund account; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's bidding requirements and reimburse Strong Signs, an Oakland small business, for the materials because the materials are provided below cost in response to efforts of the Joaquin Miller Working Group to improve the park; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** Pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.050.I.5, the City Council finds and determines that for the reasons set forth above it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's competitive bidding requirements for the purchase of this sign and so waives the requirement; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City administrator is authorized to purchase on behalf of Councilmember Jean Quan the following materials without competitive bids: seven thousand fourteen dollars and thirty eight cents (\$7,014.38) to Strong Signs for Park Signage, to be charged to the Councilmember's pay-go account.
