Adoption of the proposed ordinance will authorize the City Administrator to negotiate and execute a Disposition and Development Agreement and related documents that will provide ment and related documents that will provide for the sale of the property located at 3455 and 3461 Champion Street to Carlos Soloman and Dominica Rice-Soloman for not less than Three Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$340,000) and the development and operation on such property of a full service restaurant. The ordinance includes findings under the California Environmental Quality Act for this action.
