RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO INCLUDE PROPOSED FEE INCREASES TO RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING (RPP) IN THE 2009-2010 MASTER FEE SCHEDULE AND AUTHORIZE AN ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT RATE OF THREE PERCENT (3%) TO ALL RPP FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland periodically updates its Master Fee Schedule to account for general cost of living increases and program changes or other costs; and

WHEREAS, the fee modifications proposed herein have been justified by the Parking Division of the Finance and Management Agency on the basis of increased program costs; and

WHEREAS, the Residential Permit Parking (RPP) Program serves to preserve the livability, social benefits, and economic stability of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has a duty to enforce parking violations, as set forth by the Oakland Municipal Code, including areas where the RPP program has been authorized; and

WHEREAS, the current fees were set in 1986 when the RPP program was first implemented and fees have not been increased since then; and

WHEREAS, the cost of operating the RPP program has grown significantly and the fees collected no longer generate adequate revenue to support the program; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to make future increases on a smaller, more incremental basis; and

WHEREAS, an annual adjustment rate would adjust the RPP fees annually to keep pace with the operating cost of the program; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator be authorized to include in the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Master Fee Schedule ordinance the following increases:
