RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF JOSEPH PARKER, CHARLES ROBERSON, ET AL. V. CITY OF OAKLAND, ET AL., UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT NO. C-03-4063TEH, OUR FILE NO. 23555, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$324,000.00 OF WHICH THE CITY WOULD PAY ONLY \$24,000.00 TO PLAINTIFF CHARLES ROBERSON, AND HIS ATTORNEYS, JOHN L. BURRIS AND JAMES B. CHANIN. (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – POLICE CONDUCT)

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Joseph Parker, Charles Roberson et al. v. City of Oakland, et al., City Attorney's File No. 23555, for a sum not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$324,000.00) of which only Twenty Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000.00) will be paid by the City to Plaintiff Charles Roberson and his attorneys John L. Burris and James B. Chanin; the remaining Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) will be paid by the City's excess insurance carrier.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Twenty Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000.00) will be paid by the City to Plaintiff Charles Roberson and his attorneys John L. Burris and James B. Chanin.
