RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARY OF THE NEWLY ELECTED CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND PURSUANT TO THE OAKLAND CITY CHARTER, SECTION 401(1) EFFECTIVE 2013

WHEREAS, Section 401(1) of the Oakland City Charter provides that the salary of the elected City Attorney shall be set by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the salary may not be reduced during the City Attorney's term of office, except as part of a general reduction of salaries of all officers and employees in the same amount or proportion; and

WHEREAS, the current term of office for the City Attorney shall end on January 4, 2013;

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the salary shall be not less than 70% and no more than 90% of the average salaries of City Attorneys of California Cities with the three immediate higher and the three immediate lower cities in population to Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a thorough salary review and determined the salary range according to this formula is \$140,043 to \$180,056; and

THERFORE RESOLVED, that effective January 5, 2013, the salary of the newly elected City Attorney shall be \$165,000.
