

## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL

Resolution No. 82755 C.M.S.

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS  
DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES  
CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) ANNUALLY WITH HODGES  
LACEY & ASSOCIATES, LLC FOR AS-NEEDED REAL ESTATE  
APPRAISAL SERVICES OVER A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS**

**WHEREAS**, professional Real Estate appraisal services are needed to support various City acquisition, disposal, capital improvements and other public works related projects; and

**WHEREAS**, as-needed Real Estate appraisal services contracts allow the Real Estate Services Division to promptly respond and provide the necessary services to the City and staff in an efficient and timely manner; and

**WHEREAS**, projects will occur over the next three-year period and will require Real Estate appraisal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the as-needed Real Estate appraisal services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the as-needed Real Estate appraisal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted a competitive Request for Proposals selection process; and

**WHEREAS**, eleven firms were deemed responsive to the City's Request for Proposals process and Hodges Lacey & Associates, LLC was chosen as one of the firms to provide appraisal services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to enter into a contract, concurrent with the Redevelopment Agency, with Hodges Lacey & Associates, LLC; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that this agreement is for services of a professional nature; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that services under contract will be temporary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Contract with Hodges Lacey & Associates, LLC to provide as-needed Real Estate appraisal services; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the total amount of the Contract is for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) annually; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That for any work orders issued under this resolution requiring the use of any City General Purpose Fund money not already specifically appropriated by City Council to the project, the City Administrator shall return to the City Council for approval of the allocation of the General Purpose Fund money; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the contract term will be for three (3) years from the date of the contract; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of additional funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That a copy of the Contract will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
