RE: **A Resolution Directing Staff to Identify and Allocate Funding for the Construction of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of 64th Avenue and Foothill Boulevard**

SUMMARY

On November 10, 2009, staff presented to the Public Works Committee three City and Agency resolutions for the 66th Avenue Street Improvement Project. The committee directed staff to identify and allocate funding for the construction of a traffic signal at 64th Avenue and Foothill. This report is in response to that request.

In response to that request, a resolution has been prepared directing staff to find and allocate funding for the construction of a traffic signal at the 64th Avenue and Foothill Blvd. intersection. Staff is already moving expeditiously to design pedestrian and safety improvements at this intersection and will return to the Council with a report on funding of the requested traffic signal improvement on December 8, 2009.



RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO IDENTIFY AND ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF 64TH AVENUE AND FOOTHILL BOULEVARD
