The Committee approved recommendations as amended to include the following revisions to be scheduled to January 18, 2022 City Council Meeting:

To SECTION 9.36.620. Definitions

"Unfinished Frame or Receiver" means a piece of any material that does not constitute the FINISHED frame or receiver of a firearm, rifle, or shotgun but that has been shaped or formed in any way to become the frame or receiver of a firearm, rifle, or shotgun, and (1) which may readily be made into a functional frame or receiver through milling, drilling, or other means, OR (2) IS MARKED OR SOLD TO THE PUBLIC TO BECOME OR BE USED AS THE FRAME OR RECEIVER OF A FUNCTIONAL FIREARM, ONCE COMPLETED, ASSEMBLED OR CONVERTED.

To SECTION 9.36.660. Penalties and Disposal

Anyone may dispose of Unfinished Frames or Receivers or fully assembled Privately Manufactured Firearms that lack serial numbers by contacting the Oakland Police Department WITHOUT PENALTY within 90 days after the passage of this ordinance.
