**RESOLUTION RE-APPOINTING LILAH GREEN AND JAMES WILLIAMS, SR. AS
THE DISTRICT 6 REPRESENTATIVE TO THE WILDLIFE PREVENTION
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT (WPAD) ADVISORY BOARD**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12556 creates the Wildlife Prevention Assessment District Advisory Board, which provides oversight and program recommendations for the Assessment District, and play a key role in the continued implementation of vegetation management programs and the development of fuel management strategies; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that the Mayor shall appoint two (2) constituents who live in the Assessment District, one of whom shall be a firefighter by profession, to serve as follows: Initially, one appointee shall serve for a term of two years; the second appointee shall serve for a term of three years. Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that the At-Large Councilmember shall appoint one (1) constituent who lives in the Assessment District, and who shall serve for a term of two years. Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12556 specifies that each of the four (4) Wildfire Prevention Assessment District Councilmembers shall appoint two (2) constituents each, who live in the Assessment District to serve as follows: Initially, one appointee shall serve for a term of two years; the second appointee shall serve for a term of three years. Thereafter, each subsequent appointment shall be for a term of two years; and therefore be it

RESOLVED: that by the appointment of the Mayor the following individuals are hereby re-appointed as set forth below:

Lilah Green and James Williams, Sr., Mayoral appointments, recommended by Councilmember Desley Brooks (District 6), to continue serving on the Wildlife Prevention Assessment District (WPAD) Advisory Board for as District 6 representatives.
