Dear President De La Fuente and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and recommends settlement of the above-entitled matter arising from alleged civil rights violations during the arrest of the plaintiff for a total sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00), to be made payable to Samuel Joseph Yepez and Curtis G. Oler, Esq., his attorney.

The plaintiff alleges that on March12, 2000, a police officer used excess force on the plaintiff during his transportation to the City jail. An independent witness and the subject officer confirm that excess force was used. This case was approved for settlement in closed session June 15, 2004.

The settlement is recommended to avoid the risk of an adverse verdict at trial and the additional exposure for attorney's fees should that occur.
