

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE 90TH ANNIVERSARY OF DONAHUE GALLAGHER WOODS, LLP, THEIR PRO BONO ACCOMPLISHMENTS, AND THEIR CONTINUED COMMITMENT TO SERVING THE CITY OF OAKLAND, AND PROCLAIMING MARCH 19, 2008 AS "DONAHUE GALLAGHER WOODS DAY" IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, Donahue Gallagher Woods LLP, founded in 1918 and based in downtown Oakland, celebrates its 90th anniversary this year, and is the City of Oakland's oldest continually-operated law firm; and

WHEREAS, Donahue Gallagher Woods proudly supports numerous community programs and projects by providing pro bono legal services, having their attorneys serve on the Boards of Directors of several community and charitable organizations, and by making generous financial contributions; and

WHEREAS, the local programs supported by Donahue Gallagher Woods include, the Boys and Girls Clubs of America, the American Lung Association of the East Bay, the California Symphony Foundation, the Donald P. McCullum Youth Court, the Milagro Foundation, Rebuilding Together Oakland, and Friends of the Oakland Public Library, to name a few; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the importance of community involvement, the firm has a written pro bono policy that provides associates with full billable hour credit — with no cap — for all hours expended on approved pro bono cases, the net result being more than half of the firm's attorneys accruing over 450 pro bono hours in 2007; and

WHEREAS, Donahue Gallagher Woods was the first law firm to join the Alameda County Bar Association's Volunteer Legal Services Corporation when the program was created in 1982, and was subsequently honored for its extensive and consistent pro bono commitment by the VLSC in 2007 with the State Bar of California President's Pro Bono Service Award for a medium law firm, and was recognized for its pro bono work by the Alameda County Bar Association in 2008; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council does hereby recognize and commend Donahue Gallagher Woods LLP for its nine decades of outstanding pro bono service and many contributions to the City of Oakland and does hereby proclaim
