RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO INCREASE CONTRACTS WITH BAY AREA COMMUNITY SERVICES, AT YOUR SERVICES (AYS) V.I.P. INC., FRIENDLY TRANSPORTATION AND VETERANS TRANSPORTATION BY \$95,000 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$895,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-04 TO CONTINUE PARATRANSIT SERVICES FOR FRAIL SENIORS AND ADULTS WITH MOBILITY DISABILITIES.

WHEREAS, THE City of Oakland claims Measure B funds and has been awarded Gap funds to stabilize the program's funding for Oakland and Piedmont residents to receive paratransit services; and

WHEREAS, City of Oakland General Fund resources are available and were appropriated in the FY 2003-2004 Budget for continued delivery of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland contracts on a non-exclusive basis, with taxis and van companies to provide paratransit services for the elderly and disabled; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland supports the pilot senior shuttle service in West Oakland provided by Bay Area Community Services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to maintain this service without disruption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds these contracts will not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive civil service; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the fleet, the van equipment and the support structure to operate this service with City employees and has never provided or operated such a service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that following the bidding procedures specified in the Purchasing Ordinance is not in the best interests of the City because the City enters into contract with all taxi companies and van companies that are licensed to do business in the City and meets the City's requirements, and the City is requesting authorization to enter into non-exclusive contracts with every applicant to provide paratransit services; and

WHEREAS, all of the companies for which contracting authorization is being requested, meet the City's requirements for paratransit services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has entered into agreements with the following paratransit providers for the amounts not to exceed as specified below:

WHEREAS, the contracts are for 12 months in duration and therefore fixed; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**: That the City Manager is authorized to amend the contracts with the aforementioned service providers in the amounts specified below for the purpose of providing services to Oakland Paratransit for the Elderly and Disabled Program participants, and to conduct all negotiations execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment request, and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with its basic purpose; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, the City wishes to amend the agreements with the following paratransit providers so that the total compensation under the agreements do not exceed the amount as specified below:
