ART PROJECT

SUMMARY

At the Public Works Committee meeting of May 25, 2004, staff presented a resolution authorizing the City Manager to reject all bids for the Broadway at I-880 Public Art Project.

The Public Works Committee directed staff to investigate sources of additional funding that can be used to supplement the funding gap of this project. Staff has identified Redevelopment fund that was set aside for public art projects in the downtown area. Cultural Arts and Marketing Department is currently evaluating the availability of this fund for this project.

The Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) has also been asked to recommend allocation of some of the Redevelopment funds to this project and to determine which Alternate Bid Items should be included in this project. These items will be discussed at the PAAC monthly meeting on June 7, 2004, the day prior to the Public Works Committee meeting. Staff will present the recommendations made at the PAAC meeting verbally to the Public Works Committee.

RECOMMENDATION(S) AND RATIONALE

No action can be taken, however, until the source of funding is confirmed and recommended by the Cultural Arts and Marketing Department.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

Staff recommends that the Public Works Committee take no action on the resolution authorizing the City Manager to reject all bids for the Broadway Public Art Project pending the confirmation of the additional funding and recommendations of the PAAC.
