WHEREAS, as an employee in the Office of Planning and Building, Rhonda received an award for her contributions of time and service in the design and implementation of the Community Assistance Center which was set up for victims of the 1991 Firestorm; and

WHEREAS, in 1996 Rhonda was promoted to the Public Works Personnel Coordinator position in the Public Works Agency; and

WHEREAS, in 1997 Rhonda was once again promoted to the Support Services Supervisor post, a position she served in until her recent retirement in July 2009; and

WHEREAS, she was a the Public Works Agency's Employee of the Year for Administrative Services in 2007; and

WHEREAS, during her long career with the City of Oakland, she served on several citywide committees and teams for performance planning and appraisal system development, strategic management, and the initial service delivery system (SDS) set-up team; and

WHEREAS, Rhonda Stuart has demonstrated astute analytical abilities, and a "can-do" attitude to problem solving and meeting customer needs that has improved the delivery of services to Public Works staff and other City agencies; and

WHEREAS, Rhonda Stuart was one of the official Harry Schrauth's 'Harry's Girls'; and
