A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000 WITH THE OAKLAND PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL, INC., TO COORDINATE THE 2004 MAYOR'S SUMMER JOBS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Summer Jobs Program ("MSJP") has been in existence for 37 years and has provided summer employment opportunities for thousands of Oakland youth; and

WHEREAS, federal funding for summer employment has been abolished with the advent of the Workforce Investment Act; and

WHEREAS, extensive local public and private support is needed to provide summer employment opportunities for Oakland youth; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Private Industry Council, Inc, has agreed to participate as the coordinating agency for the Mayor's Summer Jobs Program; and

WHEREAS, because the City has identified \$40,000 in support of the Year 2004 Mayor's Summer Jobs Program in the FY 2003-2005 budget, there are sufficient funds available for this contract; and

WHEREAS, funds for the contract are available from fund number 1010, organization 90591, account 54919 and project number P49500; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this contract is of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this contract will not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having a permanent status in the competitive service; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for professional services with the Oakland Private Industry Council, Inc., to serve as the coordinating agency for the 2004 MSJP in an amount not to exceed \$40,000; and be it further
