RESOLUTION No. 76234 C. M. S.

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE FORMAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS AND PURCHASE JANITORIAL SUPPLIES BY INFORMAL BID ON THE OPEN MARKET IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE ANNUAL BUDGET AVAILABLE FOR JANITORIAL SUPPLIES IN ANY GIVEN YEAR.

WHEREAS, prices for janitorial supplies continue to fluctuate to the degree that the suppliers for janitorial supplies are unwilling to offer firm competitive prices except for short time periods; and

WHEREAS, calling for formal bids would serve no useful purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City would be able to achieve a cost savings by using informal bids to purchase janitorial products; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Services Agency Director has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the formal bidding process in accordance with the Oakland Municipal Code, Article 1, Sections 5.i.2. and 5.i.5; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council finds and determines, based on the findings set forth in the January 16, 2000 report of the Financial Services Agency Director, that it is in the best interest of the City to waive the formal bidding process and authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to purchase janitorial supplies by informal bids on the open market in an amount not to exceed the annual budget available for janitorial supplies in any given year; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post notice on the official bulletin board, in the Office of the City Clerk of Oakland California.
