Neighborhood Services Division - Crime prevention presentations to neighborhood groups, businesses, senior citizen groups. Volunteer Coordinator - In charge of the police departments volunteer in policing program. Conduct interviews and background check for new OPD volunteers. place volunteers in assignments that met the needs of both. Citizens Police Academy - plan, coordinate and implement the CPA. Schedule instructors who teach specific crime prevention subject matters to citizens of Oakland. Personnel & Training Division- participated by roleplaying in different training exercises during the police academy. Sat on oral boards for police officer applicants. Citizens Police Review Board (CPRB) 2010- 2013- As a member of the CPRB, reviewed and discussed complaints by members of the community regarding misconduct by police officers. Superior Court of California (alameda county) 2011-2021 Court Attendant - monitor the courtroom to ensure the order and silence is maintained in and near the courtroom to ensure security of the courtroom and integrity of the jury. RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF PAULA WHITE TO SERVE A FIVE-YEAR TERM ON THE POLICE COMMISSION SELECTION PANEL

WHEREAS, On November 8, 2016, Oakland voters approved Measure LL – establishing a Police Commission with 83.19% (137,032 votes) in favor of the measure; and

WHEREAS, Measure LL established City Charter Section 604 which created a seven member Police Commission to oversee the Oakland Police Department's policies and procedures and the Community Police Review Agency that investigates police misconduct and recommends discipline; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 604(c)(3) established a nine-member Selection Panel to solicit, review and interview applicants for four regular members and one alternate member to the Police Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 604(c)(3)(d) each year the Mayor and each Councilmember may replace their assigned person on the Selection Panel. Selection Panel members may serve up to five (5) years. Upon a vacancy on the Selection Panel, the Councilmember who appointed the Selection Panel member shall appoint a replacement; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Dan Kalb has nominated Paula White to serve on the Selection Panel in the District 1 seat for a five-year term; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Paula White to serve a five-year term as the District 1 representative on the Police Commission Selection Panel for a term beginning November 12, 2024 and ending November 11, 2029.
