

INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT LARRY REID

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND HONORING AL AULETTA UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE CITY OF OAKLAND AFTER 36 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE

WHEREAS, Al Auletta began his career as a Career Development Trainer, Job Developer, and Project Director for The East Oakland Youth Development Center in 1981, and thereafter, became Deputy Director and Director of Programs, Development, Planning, and Special Projects for the East Bay Conservation Corps; and

WHEREAS, Al Auletta served as The Redevelopment Area Manager for the Redevelopment Agency for the City of Oakland from July 2007 to February 2012, and later became the Workforce Development Program Manager & Executive Director of Oakland Workforce Investment Board from April 2000 – June 2007, and once again from March 2012 to June 2015; and

WHEREAS, Al Auletta was assigned as the Program Manager for the Business Sustainability Program for the City of Oakland for the Department of Housing and Community Development from July 2015 to June 2017, and implemented and managed Oakland's Bus Rapid Transit Business Sustainability Program; and

WHEREAS, Al Auletta developed programs and raised approximately \$40 million in new grant funding from public agencies, private foundations and corporations, developed and managed fee-for-service contracts totaling more than \$4 million annually, managed the City of Oakland's allocations from the Department of Labor ranging from \$6 to \$10 million annually, oversaw major projects on two former military installations in Oakland, accumulated \$27 million for the development of the former Oakland Army Base and, with multiple community stakeholders, facilitated the development of a comprehensive set of Community Jobs Policies, the formation of an Oversight Commission, and the creation of the West Oakland Job Resource Center; and

WHEREAS, Al Auletta, represented organizations at the local, state and national levels, including lobbying efforts with elected officials; collaborated with federal, state, regional, county, community, faith-based, and labor organizations on former Oakland Army Base project planning and community benefits development, and, represented the U.S. for two years as a Peace Corps Volunteer, assisting Dominicans in the areas of education and health care; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby recognizes and congratulates Al Auletta upon his retirement from the City of Oakland, after 36 years of dedicated service to the residents of Oakland.
