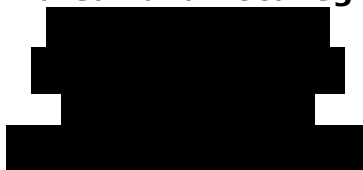

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 72727 C.M.S., adopted June 11, 1996, mid amended by Resolution No. 73916 C.M.S., adopted November 4, 1997, which changed the body's status from a Task Force to a Board, establishes that the Community Policing Advisory Board shall oversee, monitor and report at least twice yearly and provide recommendations on community policing to the Mayor, City Council, City Manager, and director of Police Services; and

WHEREAS, the Community Policing Advisory Board consists of fifteen (15) members, all Oakland residents, serving three-year terms, three appointed by the Mayor, one by each Councilmember, one by the Oakland Housing Authority, one by the Oakland Unified School District Board, and two by the Home Alert Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Sheng Thao has appointed Cynthia Elliott and Andrea Luna Bocanegra and reappointed Samuel Dawit and Colleen Brown to serve three year terms, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby confirms the appointment of the following individual to the Community Policing Advisory Board as set forth below:

Cynthia Elliott, to serve a three year term as the District 5 representative on the Community Policing Advisory Board beginning March 25, 2022 and ending March 24, 2025, filling the vacant seat previously held by Jorge Lerma.

Andrea Luna Bocanegra, to serve a three year term as the District 4 representative on the Community Policing Advisory Board beginning March 25, 2024 and ending March 24, 2027, filling the seat previously held by Jennifer Zilliac.

Samuel Dawit, to serve a three year term as a Mayoral representative on the Community Policing Advisory Board beginning March 25, 2022 and ending March 24, 2025, filling the seat previously held by himself.

Colleen Brown, to serve a three year term as a Neighborhood Watch Steering Committee representative on the Community Policing Advisory Board beginning March 25, 2022 and ending March 24, 2025, filling the seat previously held by herself.
