**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARY SCHEDULE OF ORDINANCE NO. 12187 C.M.S. ("SALARY ORDINANCE") TO ADD THE FULL-TIME CLASSIFICATION OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF WORKPLACE & EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS; TO ADD THE FULL-TIME CLASSIFICATION OF SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY SUPERVISOR; TO ADD THE FULL-TIME CLASSIFICATION OF ANIMAL CARE SERVICES SUPERVISOR; TO AMEND THE SALARY OF THE FULL-TIME CLASSIFICATION OF POLICE PROPERTY SUPERVISOR; AND TO AMEND THE TITLE OF THE FULL-TIME, PERMANENT PART-TIME AND PART-TIME EQUIVALENT CLASSIFICATIONS OF VETERINARY TECHNICIAN TO REGISTERED VETERINARY TECHNICIAN**

This ordinance authorizes changes to the City's Classification Plan as shown in the City's Salary Schedule to add new classifications and amend existing classification titles and salary rates. Various departments are requesting new classifications to align with operational and service delivery needs; this applies to the new Deputy Director of Workplace & Employment Standards, School Traffic Safety Supervisor, and Animal Care Services Supervisor. The pay rate of the existing non-sworn Police Property Supervisor classification is being adjusted to ensure alignment of similarly situated supervisory civilian classifications in the Oakland Police Department. The job title for Veterinary Technician is being adjusted to better reflect naming conventions and certification requirements in the industry; this titled change from Veterinary Technician to Registered Veterinary Technician applies to the full-time, permanent, part-time and part-time classification equivalents.

**ORDINANCE (1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO AMEND THE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR 1911 TELEGRAPH AVENUE BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE LAKE MERRITT- UPTOWN DISTRICT ASSOCIATION OF OAKLAND, TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE LICENSE AGREEMENT FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2020 TO DECEMBER 31, 2022, FOR A MONTHLY LICENSE FEE OF TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$2,250.00); AND (2) MAKING CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) EXEMPTION FINDINGS**

This Ordinance would authorize the City Administrator or designee to negotiate and enter into a first amendment to an existing license agreement for the City-owned vacant lot at 1911 Telegraph Ave., for the non-exclusive use of the property by Lake Merritt-Uptown District Association of Oakland, for an extended term ending December 31, 2022, for a fair market monthly license fee of \$2,250. The amended license agreement would permit the City to terminate the license at any time. This Ordinance also makes CEQA exemption findings for the authorization of the license and the temporary use of the vacant lot.
