- 2) A study of the screening process to find out if Oakland's 1st step screening process is in line with the practices of other cities. A review of the mix of the review panels and analysis and assessment on the make up of the review panel (# of officers, outside people, etc)
- 3) Development of an Internship Task Force program to recruit at the schools and throughout community to hire Oakland residents.
- 4) A report that prioritizes departments on level of disparity and a plan on Service Maintenance Workers with focus in major categories (i.e., Fire, Maintenance Workers, Police) and on specific areas of recruitment

Staff was also directed to provide an ethnic/gender workforce breakdown that includes: 1) who the applicants are, the final pool of applicants, and the selected hire in an effort to ensure a balanced fair hiring process

Staff was further directed to return with semi-annual updates on workforce diversity.
