# Goals of the OMCA Campus Plan

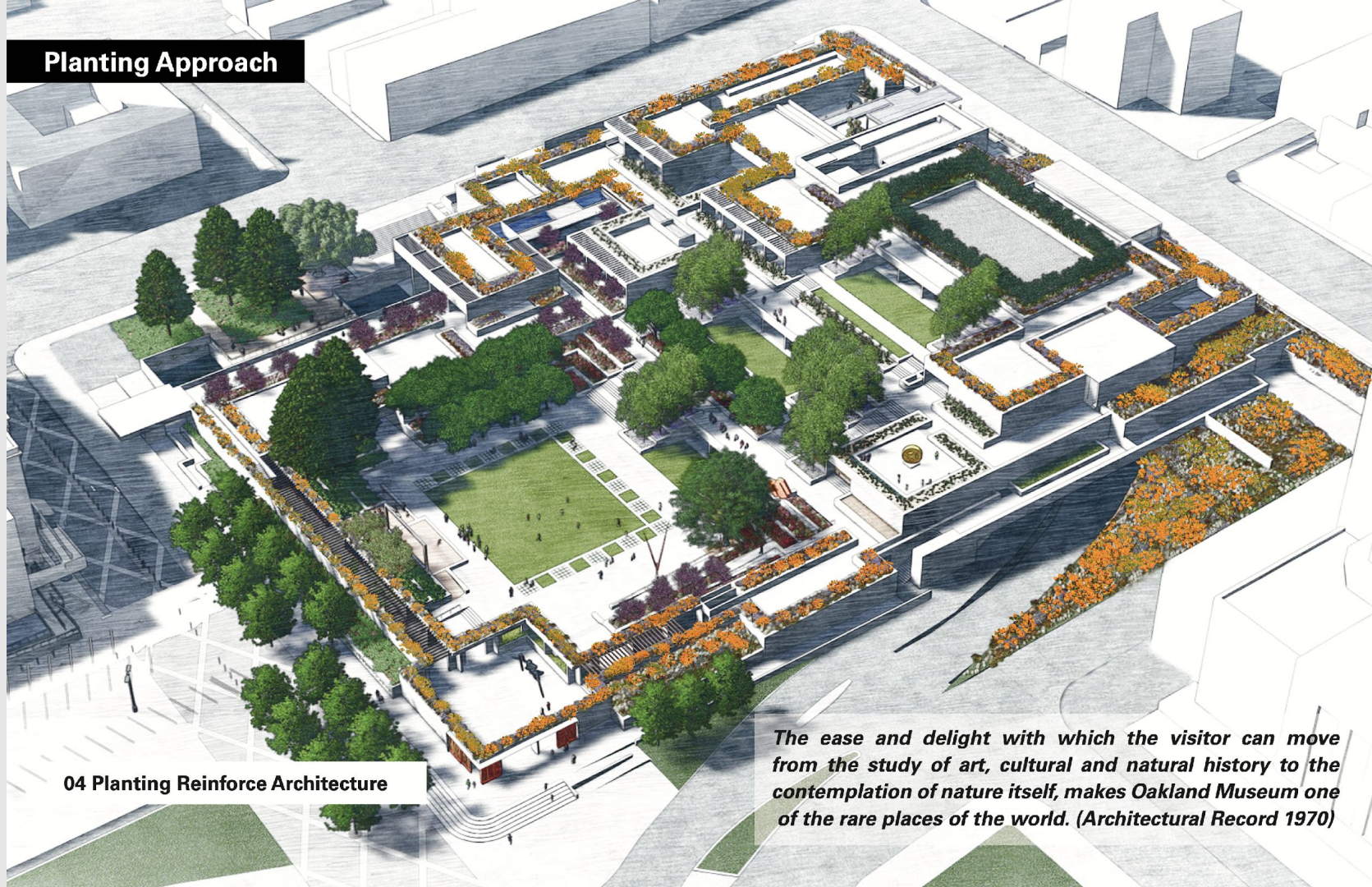
- Create a strong sense of visibility and connection

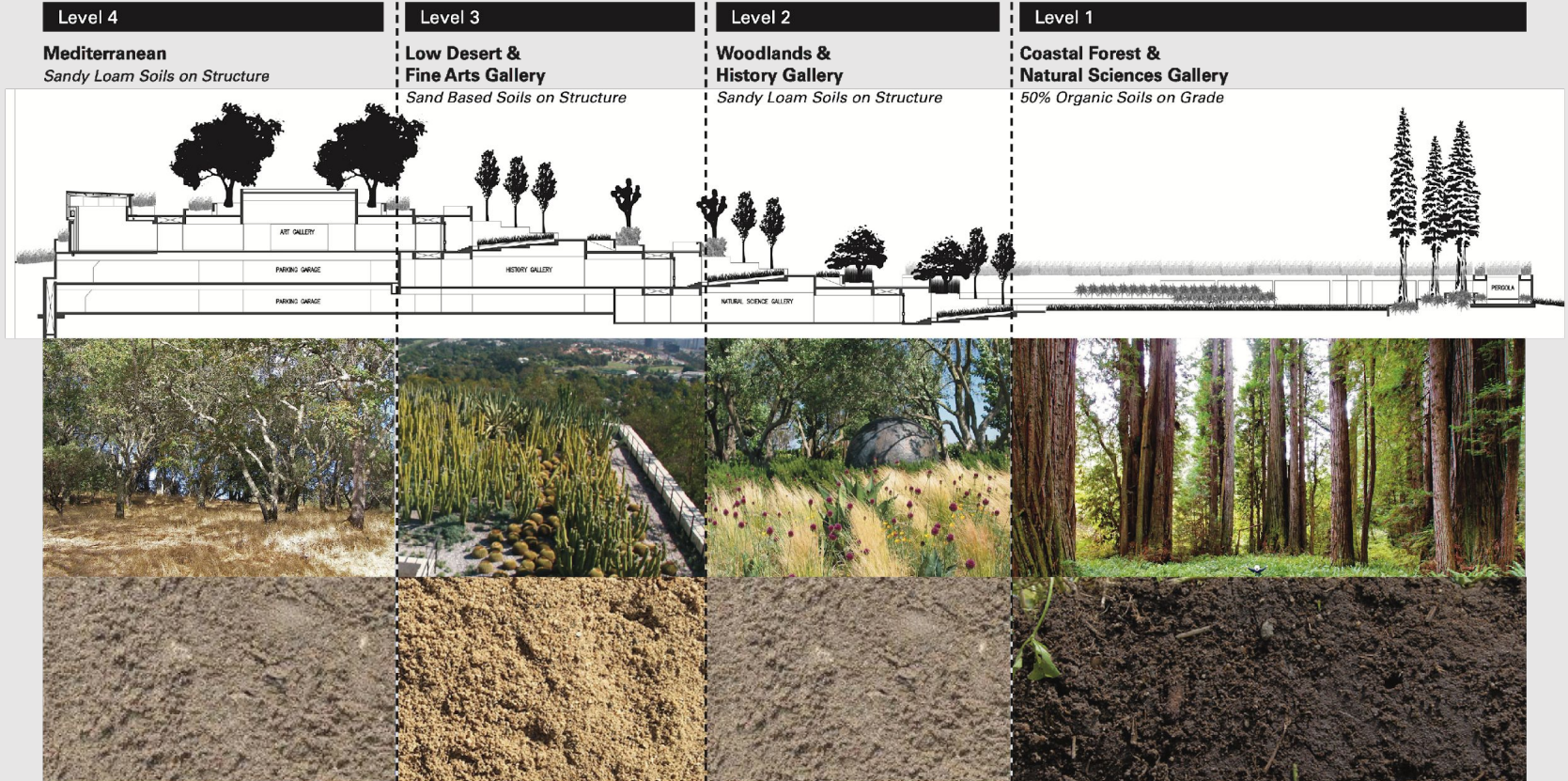

# Cross Section of California

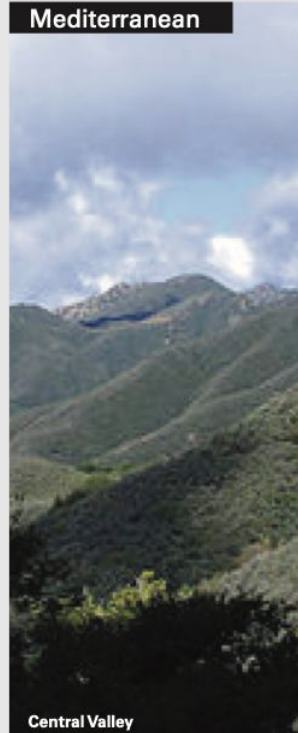
Planting by Ecoregions
