

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A TWO HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE DOLLAR (\$258,145.00) METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM (MMRS) GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY TO FUND THE MMRS PROGRAM, PLANNING AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE OAKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council has accepted prior Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) funding for all hazard mitigation, terrorism preparedness; and

WHEREAS, Oakland's MMRS consists of planning, development, purchasing special pharmaceuticals and equipment and identified training for MMRS as the principal resource in responding to health and medical consequences of a nuclear, biological or chemical terrorist incident; and

WHEREAS, the potential for loss of life and threats to the environment exist due to the use of Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Explosive Devices; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or designee to accept and appropriate a Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) grant of two hundred fifty eight thousand and one hundred forty five dollars (\$258,145.00) from the Governor's Office Of Homeland Security as a part of the 2007 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) to fund projects for all hazard mitigation.


