Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Her Designee, To Award A Construction Contract For The Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project In Accord With Specification No. P241410 To Harding Construction Inc. In The Amount Of Two Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Dollars (\$274,000.00) And To Appropriate Three Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Ten Dollars (\$333,010.00) To The Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project From The Oakland

Public Library Trust Fund

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to award a construction contract for the Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project (Project No. to be determined) with Harding Construction Inc., in the amount of two hundred seventy-four thousand dollars (\$274,000.00). Harding Construction Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder and its bid meets the City's Local Business Program requirements. Seventy-one percent (71%) of the work will be performed by small local business enterprises. Funds are available for this contract.

This project is consistent with the Mayoral and City Council goals to "Build Community and Foster Livable Neighborhoods" and "Ensure That All Oakland Youth and Seniors Have the Opportunity to be Successful." The project is located in Council District 2.

FISCAL IMPACT

The resolution will authorize a \$274,000.00 construction contract with Harding Construction Inc. Approval of this resolution will also authorize the appropriation of three hundred thirty thousand ten dollars (\$330,010.00) to the Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project from the following sources in the Oakland Public Library Trust Fund (7540):

- 1. One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$126,455.00) from the unreserved fund balance of the Oakland Public Library Trust Fund (7540).
- 2. One Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$147,555.00) from the Oakland Public Library Gift Project (P01900).
- 3. The balance of approximately Fifty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$59,000.00) from the Torrance Turner Trust 03 Project (P01900).

Public Art fees have previously been allocated. Contract Compliance fees will be allocated from the project as required.

BACKGROUND

On October 23, 2006, the City Clerk received two bids for this project. Harding Construction Inc., submitted a bid in the amount of \$274,000.00 with local and small local business participation of \$195,760.00 (71%), which exceeds the City's Local and Small Local Business Enterprise Program (L/SLBE) requirement of 20%. Rockridge Builders submitted a bid in the amount of \$390,164.00. Its bid is non-responsive because it did not list dollar amounts for its subcontractors in order for compliance with the Local Business Program to be determined. Both firms are in compliance with the Equal Benefits Ordinance. This information has been verified by the Contract Compliance and Employment Services Division of the City Administrator's Office and is shown on Attachment A.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Teen Zone occupies the southeast corner on the second floor of the Main Library located at 125 14th Street in the downtown district. Renovations to the existing teen space are needed to create an attractive and functional space dedicated for teenage library patrons. The project will provide amenities such as group study rooms, quiet reading nooks, and seating areas for socializing. The project will greatly expand the number of computers and workstations, provide improved lighting, improve access to technology for persons with disabilities, and provide new drinking fountains.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The duration of the construction work is 100 working days from the date of the Notice to Proceed. With approval of this resolution, anticipated completion is by August 2007. The construction contract specifies \$750.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time is exceeded.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: The project will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City for work on the project.

<u>Environmental</u>: The project incorporates rubber tile flooring made of recycled tires. Shelving, chairs and tables will be salvaged from the existing teen space to be reused in the renovated Teen Zone.

<u>Social Equity:</u> The project will provide upgraded facilities for the teenage population throughout the City to support their recreational and educational goals.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Accessibility improvements include new accessible drinking fountains and adjustable work stations with specialized computer software to accommodate special needs by the hearing or sight impaired.

It is recommended that the City Administrator, or her designee, be authorized to award a construction contract for the Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project to Harding Construction Inc. in the amount of \$274,000.00. Harding Construction Inc., exceeded the City's L/SLBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds available to construct this project.

Contract Compliance & Employment Services reviewed the two (2) bids received in response to the above referenced project. Below is the outcome of our compliance evaluation for the twenty percent (20%) minimum Local and Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) Program participation requirement and a preliminary review for compliance with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO).

The L/SLBE findings are as follows:

As noted above, Harding Construction, lowest responsible bidder exceeded the minimum 20% L/SLBE participation requirement. Rockridge Builders, second lowest bidder, did not list dollar amounts and therefore the bid is non-responsive. Further, compliance with the minimum 20% L/SLBE requirement could not be determined. Both firms are EBO compliant.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO AWARD A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE MAIN LIBRARY TEEN ZONE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN ACCORD WITH SPECIFICATION NO. P241410 TO HARDING CONSTRUCTION INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$274,000.00) AND TO APPROPRIATE THREE HUNDRED THIRTY THREE THOUSAND TEN DOLLARS (\$333,010.00) TO THE MAIN LIBRARY TEEN ZONE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM THE OAKLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY TRUST FUND

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2006, two bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk for the Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project from Harding Construction Inc., and Rockridge Builders; and

WHEREAS, Harding Construction Inc., is the lowest responsible bidder and has met the City's Local Business Program requirements and Equal Benefits Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, upon approval of this resolution there will be sufficient funds in the Oakland Public Library Trust Fund (7540), Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project (Project No. to be determined) to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines based on the representations set forth in the City Administrator's report accompanying this Resolution that the construction contract approved hereunder is technical and temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to award a construction contract on behalf of the City of Oakland to Harding Construction Inc. in the amount of Two Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Dollars (\$274,000.00) for the Main Library Teen Zone Improvements Project in accord with Specification No. P241410 and contractor's bid dated October 23, 2006, and to execute any amendments or modifications of said contract within

the limitations of the project specifications; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to reject all other bids; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to appropriate a total of Three Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Ten Dollars (\$333,010.00) to the Main Library Teen Zone Improvement Project (Project No. to be determined) from the following funding sources in the Oakland Public Library Trust Fund (7540):

- 1. One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$126,455.00) from the unreserved fund balance of the Oakland Public Library Trust Fund (7540);
- 2. One Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$147,555.00) from the Oakland Public Library Gift Project (P01900);
- 3. The balance of approximately Fifty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$59,000.00) from the Torrance Turner Trust 03 Project (P01900); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: The amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$274,000.00, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and material furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$274,000.00, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and, be it
