## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### **BACKGROUND AND LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

In 2013, the Public Safety Committee requested a quarterly report from OPD on crime trends and crime reduction activities in the City of Oakland. This report is provided four times a year and updated to include the preceding three-month period (January through March; April through June; July through September; and October through December).
