RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CORRECTIONS STANDARDS AUTHORITY, ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT (JABG) TO **JUVENILE IMPLEMENT** INNOVATIVE VIOLENCE AND INITIATIVES TO INTRODUCE AND EXPOSE PREVENTION DISENGAGED TEENS TO ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP **PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the State of California, Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) announced allocation of competitive funds through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG); and

WHEREAS, the goal of the JABG program is to reduce juvenile offenders through accountability based programs focused on the offender and juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) will utilize grant funds to execute "Project Resolve"; a multifaceted public safety initiative providing alternative sentencing programming and restorative justice opportunities to address youth violence, crime and negative behaviors; and

WHEREAS, as a component of Project Resolve, grant funds will support an enhanced Radical Roving Recreation program citywide and expand the operations of the newly created Receiving Center at Tassafronga Recreation Center, scheduled to open January 2009; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Administrator or his designee is authorized to apply for, accept, and appropriate grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 from the State of California, Business, Transportation and Housing Agency, Juvenile Accountability Block Grant administered by the Corrections Standards Authority for the Office of Parks and Recreation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the City Council and that all funds received will be encumbered by June 30, 2009 and liquidated by September 29, 2009, and no requests for extension will be submitted; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Oakland agrees to provide all matching funds required for this project that are the responsibility of the City as proposed, and agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the JABG Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the CSA; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the funds shall be placed in the Office of Parks and Recreation Fund (2130); Organization (505810); with a Project Account to be determined and that required matching funds in the amount of \$50,000 are available in OPR's funding block: Department of Justice Fund (2112); Radical Roving Organization (505810); Recreation Program (NB03); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney has approved this resolution as to form and legality and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
