RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR  
FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIIB OF THE  
CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION

WHEREAS, Article XIIB of the California Constitution (Limitation of Government Appropriations) was passed by the California electorate on November 6, 1979, and became effective on July 1, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Chapter 1205, Statute of 1980, Section 7900 of the Government Code, formally implements methods for governmental entities to establish and define annual appropriations limits, based on annual appropriations for the prior fiscal year, which is fiscal year 2002-03, for fiscal year 2003-04; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the annual appropriations limit for FY 2003-04 is \$344,028,344; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: the growth factors used to calculate the limit are the county population change and the increase in the California per capita income.
