**Re: Supplemental to A Report and Proposed Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator, on Behalf of the City of Oakland, to Accept and Appropriate Grant Funds in an Amount Not to Exceed Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$298,070) from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, for the Fiscal Year 2009 Implementation of the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program in the Police Department**


On April 8, 2008, the Police Department presented a report and proposed resolution authorizing the acceptance and appropriation of Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$298,070) in grant funds from the California Office of Traffic Safety for supplemental law enforcement services and other innovative strategies to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in traffic collisions in the City of Oakland.


The Public Safety Committee requested supplemental information on statistics related to special enforcement operations. The following statistics are from grant related operations for the period of July 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008:

- Citations Issued 2884
- DUI Arrests 61
- Felony Arrests 8
- Unlicensed Vehicles Towed 256
- Weapons Recovered 7
