

Public Hearing on the Assessment of Liens for Delinquent Real

**Property Transfer Taxes** 

#### **SUMMARY**

On November 1, 2004 pursuant to Chapter 4.20 of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing for delinquent real estate transfer taxes was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners prior to the public hearing before City Council.

A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on three accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment of all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of the City's submission to the County Assessor.

### FISCAL IMPACT

Property owners owe the City delinquent real property transfer taxes and administrative fees for the accounts not resolved at the November 1, 2004 administrative hearings. Failure to place a lien to recover the tax will result in an estimated loss of \$30,643.83 revenue to the City's General Fund.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City notified property owners of the City's intent to record a lien against their property. Twenty cases were resolved and removed from the list of delinquent properties.

A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on three accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.
