RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO AJW CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURB RAMPS CITYWIDE – PHASE V (PROJECT NO. G166810, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. STPL-5012 (060) FOR THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT

THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS \$538,500

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Manager to award a construction contract in the amount of \$538,500 to AJW Construction for the Construction of Curb Ramps Citywide – Phase V (Project No. G166810, Federal Project No. STPL-5012 (060). The work to be completed under this project is part of the City's ongoing curb ramp construction program. The work will be at various locations throughout the City.

FISCAL IMPACTS

Project funding is available from Federal Highway Funds in Fund 2116, Organization 92242, Account 57411, and Project G166810. The engineer's estimate for the work is \$622,300.

BACKGROUND

On June 2, 2003, the City Clerk received seven bids for this project. Bids from Vanguard Construction and Professional Construction Services were deemed non-responsive, and were rejected. The bids are shown in *Attachment A*. The lowest responsible bidder, AJW Construction with a bid price of \$538,500, is recommended for award.

The proposed work consists of constructing 320 curb ramps, one median cut walkway, 19,680 square feet of concrete sidewalk repair, 200 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter, and 100 square feet of asphalt concrete pavement repair. This project meets the Mayor/City Council Goals and Citywide Objectives #3 Improve Oakland Neighborhoods, and #6 Maintain & Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets.

Federal Department of Transportation funding guidelines are used to administer this project, and therefore the City's local programs are not applicable. The City of Oakland Contract Compliance Division has determined that the project has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 5%. AJW's proposal includes 100% DBE participation, and therefore meets and exceeds this goal.

The bidders' DBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction is scheduled to begin in August 2003 and be completed by December 2003. The contract specifies \$250 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contractor exceeds the contract completion time of 80 working days. The project schedule is shown on *Attachment A*.

Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and determined that the low bid is reasonable.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

The construction of curb ramps and sidewalk repairs will improve air quality to the extent that pedestrian traffic is encouraged. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Construction of 320 new curb ramps and repair of sidewalks will improve access to City streets and sidewalks for senior citizens, persons with disabilities and all pedestrians in general. Curb ramps will be constructed to current state and federal standards.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to AJW Construction, the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$538,500 for the Construction of Curb Ramps Citywide – Phase V (Project No. G166810, Federal Project No. STPL-5012 (060) in the amount of \$538,500. The contractor, AJW Construction, has met the DBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2003, seven bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for the Construction of Curb Ramps Citywide - Phase V (Project No. G166810, Federal Project No. STPL-5012 (060) of which two were non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, AJW Construction has been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder for the project; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in Fund 2116, Organization 92242, Account 57411, and Project G166810, for the contract work; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance; and

WHEREAS, AJW Construction complies with the applicable federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the contract for the Construction of Curb Ramps Citywide - Phase V (Project No. G166810, Federal Project No. STPL-5012 (060) is hereby awarded to AJW Construction in accordance with the terms of its bid therefore, dated June 2, 2003, for the amount of Five Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$538,500); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That in the event that bids are not received, or bids are deemed not responsive, the City Manager is authorized to reject bids and negotiate a contract not to exceed \$538,500, without return to Council; and be it
