A Report and Proposed Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator, on Behalf of the City of Oakland, to Execute an Agreement with the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) for the Purpose of Permitting the Police Department to Present the POST Certified Academy Recruit Training Officer Course up to three times to 72 Students, and to Receive up to Nine Thousand Three Hundred and Seven Dollars and Ninety Eight Cents (\$9,307.98) in Reimbursement Funds

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to execute an agreement with the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) for the purpose of permitting the Oakland Police Department to present the POST certified Academy Recruit Training Officer (RTO) Course up to three times during the term of the contract, and receive reimbursement funds up to \$9,307.98.

FISCAL IMPACT

The \$9,307.98 covers the cost of full coordination of up to three course presentations. The maximum reimbursable amount of \$9,307.98 will train 72 students. The term of the agreement with POST is July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, for presentation of the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course. Reimbursement funds shall be deposited into General Purpose Fund (1010), Training Section Organization Code (103430), Training Program Code (PS09), and Registration and Tuition Account (55212).

BACKGROUND

The Police Department routinely conducts POST certified training courses for the benefit of Oakland police officers and officers from other law enforcement agencies. The City of Oakland has been coordinating the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course for POST since 1991.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The requirements for the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course are specified by POST and include foundational information about Basic Academy Training and POST laws and regulations.

All Recruit Training Officers throughout the state must attend the course within one year of appointment to the position. The City of Oakland has been the sole presenter of the Recruit Training Officer Course for the State of California since 1991.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The key topics covered in the training are:

- Legal/Liability Issues
- Roles of the Academy Recruit Training Officer
- POST Physical Conditioning Program
- Adult Learning Theory and Instructional Techniques
- Leadership, Ethics and Professionalism

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

The benefit of having certified Recruit Training Officers is the assurance that new officers who attend the Oakland Police Academy are provided with current industry standard instruction and training, which increases public safety, officer safety, and service to the City. Officers who are well trained are better prepared to perform their duties as public servants and add to the quality of life throughout the community.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (POST) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PRESENT THE POST CERTIFIED ACADEMY RECRUIT TRAINING OFFICER COURSE TO SEVENTY TWO (72) STUDENTS, AND TO RECEIVE UP TO NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVEN DOLLARS AND NINETY EIGHT CENTS (\$9,307.98) IN REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has requested that the City of Oakland Police Department present the POST certified Academy Recruit Training Officer Course to California Law Enforcement personnel who are appointed to the position of Academy Recruit Training Officer; and

WHEREAS, POST will reimburse the Police Department for up to three presentations of the Recruit Training Officer Course, not to exceed 72 total students, up to a maximum amount of \$9,307.98, during the period of July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Oakland to execute an agreement with POST for the purposes described above; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has executed similar agreements with POST and has been the sole presenter of the Recruit Training Officer Course for the State of California since 1991; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designees is hereby authorized to submit and execute an agreement between the City of Oakland and POST for the purposes described above; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the money shall be appropriated to the Police Department General Purpose Fund (1010), Training Section Organization Code (103430), Training Program Code (PS09), and Registration and Tuition Account (55212).
