The Citizens' Police Review Board investigates and reviews certain complaints regarding conduct of Oakland police officers and park rangers and thereafter delivers in a timely manner advisory reports to the City Administrator regarding the facts of and recommended disposition of these complaints as well as disciplinary recommendations, if appropriate. In addition, the Board may recommend policy changes to the Public Safety Committee regarding matters within its jurisdiction.
