Nominated by Mayor, confirmed by City Council.

Nine members, and three alternate members, two-year staggered terms, no more than two consecutive terms. A member must be at least 18 years old at the time of appointment. One of the nine members and one of the three alternate members must be under the 25 years old at the time of appointment. The Citizens' Police Review Board investigates and reviews certain complaints regarding conduct of Oakland police officers and park rangers and thereafter delivers in a timely manner advisory reports to the City Administrator regarding the facts of and recommended disposition of these complaints as well as disciplinary recommendations, if appropriate. In addition, the Board may recommend policy changes to the Public Safety Committee regarding matters within its jurisdiction.

The City Planning Commission considers and reviews matters related to planning, development and preservation, and advises the City Council on land use and environmental concerns.

Members of this Commission must submit a Conflict of Interest form (Form 700).
