RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Receive An Oakland Police Department (OPD) Supplemental Strategic Plan Informational Report. The Report Provides Additional Information Regarding Neighborhood Services, Goals On Providing High Quality Public Service, Ways OPD Will Work In Partnership With All Agencies To Achieve Safe And Livable Neighborhoods, And How To Create And Sustain A Resilient And Economically Prosperous City With Opportunity In Every Community And / Or District.

REASON FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

OPD presented information about strategic areas of focus at the April 9, 2019 Public Safety Committee (PSC). The PSC requested a timeline for when each of the strategic areas would be presented.

OPD has been presenting specific focus areas to the PSC: a report on sideshow response was presented to the May 28, 2019, and a report on human trafficking has been scheduled to the June 11, 2019 PSC. The table below provides a tentative schedule for bringing forward further policing areas of focus discussed at the April 9, 2019 PSC.
