

NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.04, PURCHASING SYSTEM, TO ADD SECTION 2.04.022 TO AUTHORIZE THE POLICE COMMISSION TO PURCHASE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES NECESSARY TO FULFILL ITS DUTIES AS DEFINED IN MEASURE LL, CODIFIED IN SECTION 604 OF THE OAKLAND CITY CHARTER

This Ordinance will amend Oakland's Purchasing Ordinance codified at Oakland Municipal Code Title 1, Chapter 2.04, to add provisions that authorize Oakland's Police Commission to authorize contracts for professional, technical and scientific services needed for the Commission to fulfill its powers and duties as specified in Oakland Charter section 604(b). This amendment further provides that the contracting budget for the Commission shall be limited by specific line item allocations approved by the City Council, and will authorize the Director of the Community Police Review Agency, who is hired by and reports to the Commission, to execute contracts approved by the Commission on its behalf.

Notice of Publication

This Ordinance was introduced at the City Council meeting, Tuesday evening **June 18, 2019**, and passed to print **8 Ayes**. Final adoption has been scheduled for the City Council meeting Tuesday evening **July 9, 2019, 5:30 p.m.**, at One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Council Chamber, 3rd floor, Oakland, California.
