

Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 12676 C.M.S. (FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule), as amended; to modify Rent Adjustment and Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher Fees assessed by the Community and Economic Development

Agency

SUMMARY

An ordinance has been prepared to modify Rent Adjustment and Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher Fees assessed by the Community and Economic Development Agency. Due to a clerical error, an incorrect interim FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule was inadvertently forwarded to the Budget Office. This error was not detected until recently. The FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule needs to be modified for two types of fees, Rent Adjustment and Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher fees. The correct fees are reflected in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Budget, and this action will bring the FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule in line with the FY 2005-07 Adopted Budget.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the FY 2005-07 Adopted Budget resulting from adoption of the corrected fees. However, if the corrected fees are not adopted, revenues for rent adjustment fees in the General Purpose Fund (#1010) in the Miscellaneous Fees Account (#45419) would be 10% higher than allowed by the legislation. This would result in an over collection of approximately \$150,000. In addition, revenues would be reduced by \$75,000 for the Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher fees, Job Training Partnership Act Grants Account (#46125) in the Workforce Development Fund (#2195).

BACKGROUND

The 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule was adopted with the FY 2005-07 Budget on June 28, 2005 in Ordinance Number 12676 C.M.S. At the October 13, 2005 meeting of the Rules Committee, this item was approved to go directly to the City Council meeting of November 15, 2005, due to the fact that there was no room on the November 8th Finance and Management Committee meeting and there was an urgency to correct this clerical error in December. The Public Hearing and first reading of the Ordinance will take place on November 15, 2005. The second reading would be at the next City Council meeting on December 6, 2005.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Due to a clerical error, a 10% cost of living adjustment escalator was inadvertently added to the Rent Adjustment fees making them higher than allowed by the legislation. The same escalator was applied to Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher fees, resulting in a \$44.00 fee rather than the \$50.00 approved in the FY 2005-07 Adopted Budget. The increase was needed to offset administrative costs of \$10.00 per voucher. Without the increase only \$4.00 of the \$10.00 will be collected, resulting in a \$75,000 shortfall in revenues. Few vouchers have been issued to date so the decrease in revenues resulting from the lower fee should be minimal if the increased fee is adopted.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic:</u> The revenues collected will support the Rent Adjustment and Workforce Development programs of the City.

Environmental: There are no environmental opportunities as the result of the amendment of the FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule.

<u>Social Equity:</u> The Rent Adjustment Fees and Workforce Development fees support two programs which support social equity to all City residents.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no impact to disabled or senior citizen access.

RECOMMENDATION(S) AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the ordinance modifying the FY 2005-06 Master Fee Schedule, for Rent Adjustment and Workforce Development fees assessed by the Community and Economic Development Agency. A public hearing will be scheduled at the time of the first reading of the proposed ordinance on November 15, 2005. The proposed fees are detailed in Exhibit A.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the ordinance.



Notice is hereby given that on **Tuesday, November 15, 2005, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible, in **Oakland City Hall, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza**, the Oakland City Council will hold a public hearing during the first reading of a proposed ordinance to amend the Rent Adjustment and Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher fees charged by the Community and Economic Development Agency. The purpose of the public hearing is to hear testimony of all interested parties and to adopt an ordinance amending Ordinance 12676 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule).

The fees are being amended due to a clerical error which incorrectly showed Rent Adjustment fees as being increased by 10% when in fact there should have been no increase. Also, the Enterprise Zone Hiring Credit Voucher fee was incorrectly shown as \$44.00 when it should have been listed as \$50.00 in the Master Fee Schedule as contained in Ordinance 12676 C.M.S. The proposed ordinance to amend the Master Fee Schedule would become effective on December 6, 2005 and remain in effect until further notice. Said public hearing may be adjourned from time to time until completed.

All interested parties are welcome to attend and present comments on the proposed amendment to the Master Fee Schedule.
