RESOLUTION NO. _____ C.M.S.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE SELECTION PANEL'S SLATE OF ONE POLICE COMMISSIONER (JESSE HSIEH) AND ONE ALTERNATE POLICE COMMISSIONER (ANGELA JACKSON-CASTAIN) TO SERVE ON THE CITY OF OAKLAND POLICE COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, On November 8, 2016, Oakland voters approved Measure LL – establishing a Police Commission with 83.19% (137,032 votes) in favor of the measure; and

WHEREAS, Measure LL established City Charter Section 604 which created a seven-member Police Commission to oversee the Oakland Police Department's policies and procedures and the Community Police Review Agency that investigates police misconduct and recommends discipline; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 604(c)(2) required the Mayor to appoint three Oakland residents as regular members of the Commission and one Oakland resident as an alternate member and to submit those names to the City Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 604(c)(3) established a nine-member Selection Panel to review applications, interview applicants, and submit a slate of four Oakland residents as regular members of the Police Commission, and one Oakland resident as an alternate member, to the City Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, The initial members of the Police Commission were accepted by the City Council on October 17, 2017, and held their first meeting on December 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, The initial members of the Police Commission served staggered terms of two, three, or four years; subsequent appointments serve terms of three years; and for vacancies that occur for reasons other than the expiration of a term, the Commission shall select one of the alternates to replace the regular member for that regular member's remaining term of office; and

WHEREAS, Police Commissioner Jesse Hsieh and Alternate Police Commissioner Angela Jackson-Castain are currently serving terms that each expire on October 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Panel, at its meeting of August 10, 2022, nominated Jesse Hsieh to serve as a Police Commissioner and Angela Jackson-Castain to serve as an Alternate Police Commissioner for full three-year terms commencing on October 17, 2022; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter Sections 604(c)(3), the City Council hereby accepts the Selection Panel slate in its entirety to serve on the Police Commission as follows:

Jesse Hsieh, Commissioner Term: October 17, 2022 – October 16, 2025

Angela Jackson-Castain, Alternate Commissioner Term: October 17, 2022 – October 16, 2025
