

RESOLUTION No. 83419 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS (ABAG) TO ACCEPT UP TO FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) WORTH OF FREE STORM WATER TRASH CONTROL DEVICES, THAT WILL BE PAID FOR BY AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (ARRA) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland seeks to enter into an agreement with the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to accept free storm water trash control devices; and

WHEREAS, the ABAG has received funding from the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act through the California State Department of Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, the ABAG has currently allocated at least two hundred and forty thousand dollars (\$240,000.00) to the City of Oakland for the purchase of storm water trash control devices for Oakland storm water projects; and

WHEREAS, the ABAG will purchase up to four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00) worth of storm water trash control devices for Oakland if other cities elect not to participate in the program and more funding becomes available for Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the trash control devices provided under the ABAG agreement will improve water quality by removing trash from City of Oakland waterways and Oakland Estuary; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will defray the City of Oakland's costs in meeting required trash reduction targets; and

WHEREAS, the products provided under the ABAG agreement will help meet Council goals to develop a sustainable city and to foster livable neighborhoods; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to apply for and accept up to four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00) worth of storm water trash control devices from ABAG; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his

designee to enter into an agreement with the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to accept free storm water trash control devices worth up to four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby approves the acceptance and appropriation of these goods for existing and planned storm water quality improvement projects under the Watershed and Stormwater Management Organization (30245); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said ABAG agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney's Office for form and legality and shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is authorized to negotiate, execute and amend an agreement with the Association of Bay Area Governments and any amendments or change orders thereto and certify acceptance of the free storm water trash control devices on behalf of the City.
