WHEREAS, Section 10.24.040 of the Oakland Municipal Code was found to be preempted by California Vehicle Code Section 21954(a) in the court case of People v. McNeil, decided March 21, 2002; now, therefore

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Standing in roadways

Section 1. Oakland Municipal Code Section 10.24.040, "Standing in Roadways," is hereby repealed.
