#### 2024 State Legislative Session Overview



The 2024 Legislative Year adjourned on August 31:

- 2,124 bills were introduced in 2024
  - 1,505 Assembly Bills
  - 619 Senate Bills
- Over 400 "two-year bills" from 2023 were eligible for consideration in 2024.
- Governor Newsom has until September 30 to act on measures.
  - 983 bills reached Governors Desk

## 2024 Federal Legislative Session Overview



Congress will temporarily extend existing funding as FY2025 spending bills will not be conferenced, approved by both chambers, and signed into law by the expiration date of September 30.

There is general agreement that a continuing resolution should run until December.

Other legislation under consideration includes the National Defense Authorization Act, Water Resources Development Act, the Farm Bill, Coast Guard Reauthorization, and extensions of Medicaid and other health care provisions.




