WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8065 C.M.S., adopted November 13, 1969 and amended by Ordinance Nos. 11731 C.M.S., and 13622 C.M.S., establishes the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission to advise the Mayor, City Council, City Administrator and the Office of Parks and Recreation on all matters relating to the general policy and operation of the parks and recreation system; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission consists of eleven (11) members who are all residents of the City serving no more than two consecutive three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Sheng Thao has appointed Kye Whitmore to serve the remainder of the following unexpired three-year term that has been vacated and the subsequent three-year term, subject to confirmation by the City Council; and

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission:

Kye Whitmore, to serve the remainder of a three-year term on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission that began November 17, 2020 and ends November 16, 2023, filling a seat vacated by Sheryl Watson.
