President Fortunato Bas and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled lawsuit for the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$40,000.00), payable to Denise Knott through Knott's attorneys at West Coast Trial Lawyers.

Plaintiff Denise Knott ("Knott") was employed as a receptionist in the Oakland City Council Office from May 8, 2023 to June 30, 2023. Knott sued the City alleging employment discrimination based on race, harassment, and retaliation. Knott claims Knott suffered wage loss and emotional distress.

The approved settlement in the amount of \$40,000.00, without admitting fault or liability, resolves all of Knott's claims, avoids further litigation, and is in the City's best interest.

The City Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Thursday, November 21, 2024 (moved by Councilmember Noel Gallo and seconded by Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan - 6 Ayes, 2 Absent – Councilmembers Janani Ramachandran and Treva Reid).
