

**RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING CARLOS MIGUEL P. BRIONES,  
WINNER OF THE 2009 SAN FRANCISCO CITY GOLF  
CHAMPIONSHIP AT THE AGE OF 14, BECOMING THE  
YOUNGEST WINNER IN THE EVENTS 93 YEAR HISTORY**

**WHEREAS**, Carlos Briones was introduced to the game of golf through a free clinic hosted at the Tony Lema Golf Course when he was seven years old; and

**WHEREAS**, Carlos began playing competitive golf at the age of eight and has never stopped competing; and

**WHEREAS**, Carlos began golfing with the Metropolitan Junior Golf Association, hosted by Oakland's Metropolitan Golf Course, in 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, Carlos is a four time Junior All Star Champion; a two time National Finalist at Golf Channel's Drive, Chip and Putt; placed third at the Junior World Golf Championship; won the 2007 Western State Golf Association Junior qualifying him for Junior PGA Tour; and

**WHEREAS**, Carlos won the 2009 San Francisco City Golf Championship, an open adult competition, making him the youngest winner since the inaugural event in 1917; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** that the City Council hereby extends their congratulations to Carlos Miguel P. Briones for accomplishing so much at such a young age and wishes him the best of luck on his future golf career.


