RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 27 – OCTOBER 3, 2009 AS SEA OTTER AWARENESS WEEK.
WHEREAS, the sea ofter is a symbol of wilderness, an integral part of California's natural ecosystem, and serves as an indicator for the overall health of California's near shore marine ecosystem; and

RESOLVED: that the Oakland City Council calls for the reestablishment of conditions that allow the sea otter to flourish as it graces our sea coast and hereby proclaims the last week of September to be Sea Otter Awareness Week.
