

**RESOLUTION WAIVING CITY'S COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS FOR A SMALL PAY-GO FUNDED PURCHASE IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY TWO DOLLARS (\$1,392.00) FOR FLOWER BOXES TO IMPROVE DIMOND PARK**

WHEREAS, Materials for Construction of Redwood Flower Boxes have been obtained through the Good Cents nonprofit organization and provided for the improvement of Dimond Park; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jean Quan wishes to reimburse this provider out of her pay-go fund account; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's bidding requirements and reimburse Montclair Garden Company, an Oakland local business, for they donated the labor for construction and installation, and materials are provided at cost in response to efforts by the Good Cents Non-profit Organization and City employees to improve the park; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** Pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.050.I.5, the City Council finds and determines that for the reasons set forth above it is in the City's best interests to waive the City's competitive bidding requirements for this purchase and so waives the requirement; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City administrator is authorized to purchase on behalf of Councilmember Jean Quan the following materials without competitive bids: one thousand three hundred ninety two dollars (\$1,392.00) to Montclair Garden Company for Materials cost only of Flower Boxes, to be charged to the Councilmember's pay-go account.
