RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO THE RESPONSIBLE LOW BIDDER, MCGUIRE AND HESTER, IN AN AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,378,195.00) FOR THE COLISEUM TRANSIT HUB STREETSCAPE (SAN LEANDRO STREET FROM 66TH AVE. TO 73RD AVE.) PROJECT

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared for Council to authorize award of a construction contract to McGuire and Hester in the amount of \$1,378,195.00 for the Coliseum Transit Hub Streetscape (San Leandro Street from 66th Ave. to 73rd Ave.) project. The project is located in Council District 7.

McGuire and Hester is the responsible low bidder and has met all the contract requirements.

Funds are available for the contract work. The project is consistent with the City Council Budget Priority, **Build Community and Foster Livable Neighborhoods** by providing accessible streets, sidewalks, amenities and trees, and by improving perception of safety.

Staff recommends that the resolution be approved.

Funding is budgeted for this project as shown in the following table:

The construction contract is in the amount of \$1,378,195.00 (Base bid of \$1,324,195.00 plus Additive Alternate 3A of \$54,000.00), and the construction contingency is \$68,909.75 (5% of the contract amount). The project budget has sufficient funds to cover the construction, contingency and construction management costs of the project.

BACKGROUND

On April 22, 2005, Notices to Bidders were sent to all contractors holding an "A" License in the City's database and the Outreach and Builder Exchange. On April 21, and 22, 2005, advertisement soliciting bids was placed in the Oakland Tribune and San Francisco Chronicle newspapers. On May 16, 2004, the City Clerk received four bids for the project as follows:

The Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) goal required for federally funded projects is zero percent for this project. The City has reached its required annual DBE goal for the City-wide DBE program. Thus, a zero DBE goal was set for this project. However, contractors were encouraged to include DBE participation in the contract.

McGuire and Hester has 8.71% DBE participation in its bid, which exceeds the zero percent DBE goal. Contract Compliance has determined that McGuire and Hester meets the DBE requirement and is the responsible low bidder. Although the City's SLBE/LBE Program does not apply to this project, the low bidder meets these program goals also.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The Coliseum Transit Hub Streetscape project emerged from a public safety planning effort initiated by a community and agency partnership called the Coliseum BART Station Area Improvement Task Force (SAITF). The task force conducted a Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) planning study of the Coliseum area in fall of 2001. The study identified the proposed streetscape project as a key investment to reduce crime and improve safety in the Coliseum BART station area by improving physical elements such as street lighting, sidewalks, and landscaping.

Council approved the following Resolutions authorizing the City to accept and appropriate funds for the Coliseum Streetscape project:

On October 15, 2002, Council approved the Resolution No. 77482 authorizing Oakland Redevelopment Agency (ORA) to apply, accept and appropriate Metropolitan Transportation Commission for Livable Communities Capital Grant funds and to use ORA funds for the matching the fund.

On April 15, 2003, Council approved Resolution No. 77747, authorizing acceptance and appropriate Transportation Funds for Clean Air (TFCA) funds from the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency (ACCMA).

On December 16 2003, Council approved the Resolution No. 78229 authorizing acceptance and appropriate the regional Bay Area Air Quality Management District Transportation Funds for Clean Air (BAAQMD/TFCA) to complement the MTC funding.

On May 16, 2004, Council approved Resolution No. 78401 authorizing acceptance and appropriate of \$600,000.00 Federal Transportation Administration (FTA) accepted through AC Transit.

On August 23, 2004, Caltrans Local Assistance and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) authorized the City to advertise, award and construct the project. Alameda County Congestion Management Agency for Transportation Funds for Clean Air (ACCMA/TFCA) grant required that City of Oakland begin to spend the funds no later than the end of September 2005.

The project should break ground no later than mid-August 2005 and construction should be complete in early December 2005 to take advantage of anticipated good weather conditions. The construction duration for completing the contract work is 60 working days. The contract stipulates \$550.00 in liquidated damages for each day that the contract work is delayed.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project seeks to reduce crime and improve vehicular and pedestrian traffic safety and traffic flow; calm traffic; encourage alternate modes of transportation; and enhance the aesthetics of San Leandro Street in the Coliseum BART station area by improving physical elements through the construction of sidewalks, crosswalks, wheelchair ramps, and a landscaped median; installation of pedestrian level lights and streetlights, traffic signals, video cameras, irrigation systems, ornamental fencing, lighted bollards, and bus shelters; and installation of pavement marking and striping; and planting trees and shrubs. The project will complement the newly opened Amtrak Station with our pedestrian signalized crossing from BART.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: Implementation of the project provides the opportunity to use local contractors, which offers employment openings to Oakland residents, thereby strengthening the local economy. The physical improvements to the Coliseum BART Station area will help reduce crime and protect the economic vitality of the community.

<u>Environmental</u>: The proposed project encourages the use of public transit and walking as alternative modes of transportation. The use of alternative modes of transportation will result in vehicle emission reduction to the environment thereby improving air quality.

<u>Social Equity</u>: The project provides greater accessibility and safety to persons who depend on non-motorized transportation and public transit to access jobs and services.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

This project will reconstruct curb ramps and provide detectable warning tiles that meet the federal Americans with Disabilities Act, making them safe and usable for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. The traffic calming elements of this project will add to this benefit.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution authorizing award of a construction contract to McGuire & Hester in the amount of \$1,378,195.00. McGuire and Hester has met the DBE requirements, and the project budget has sufficient funds to cover the contract work.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the resolution be approved.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO THE RESPONSIBLE LOW BIDDER, MCGUIRE AND HESTER, IN AN AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE DOLLARS (\$1,378,195.00) FOR THE COLISEUM TRANSIT HUB STREETSCAPE (SAN LEANDRO STREET FROM 66TH AVE. TO 73RD AVE.) PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Coliseum Transit Hub Streetscape (San Leandro Street from 66th Ave. to 73rd.) is a community-requested project which is consistent with the City Council Budget Priority, Build Community and Foster Livable Neighborhoods by providing accessible streets, sidewalks, amenities and trees, and by improving perception of safety; and

WHEREAS, the project improvements include construction of sidewalks, crosswalks, wheelchair ramps, and median; installation of pedestrian level lights and streetlights, traffic signals, video cameras, irrigation systems, ornamental fencing, lighted bollards, and bus shelters; and installation of pavement marking and striping; and planting trees and shrubs. These elements provide sustainable opportunities to the local economy, environment and social equity for the Coliseum Bart Station area and the neighborhood. The project also meets the federal Americans with Disabilities Act requirements; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2005, Notices to Bidders were sent to all contractors holding an "A" License in the City's database and the Outreach and Builder Exchange. On April 21, and 22, 2005, advertisement soliciting bids was placed in the Oakland Tribune and San Francisco Chronicle newspapers; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2005, the City Clerk received four bids and determined that McGuire and Hester is the responsible low bidder and its Disadvantage Enterprise Business participation exceeds the zero percent requirement for the project. A zero DBE goal was set for this project because the City has reached its required annual DBE goal for the City-wide DBE program. McGuire and Hester is the responsible low bidder with the amount of \$1,378,195.00; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available in the project budget to cover the construction contract including five percent (5%) contingency and construction management costs for the project. Funding is budgeted for this project as shown in the following table:
