**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON BANCROFT AVENUE AT 77<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE**

WHEREAS, a traffic signal is warranted at the intersection of Bancroft Avenue and 77<sup>th</sup> Avenue based on accident history, vehicle and pedestrian volumes, and distance to adjacent traffic signals; and,

WHEREAS, Caltrans' *Traffic Manual* provides that "Where traffic signals are warranted and urgently needed, the multiway stop may be an interim measure that can be installed quickly to control traffic while arrangements are being made for the signal installation"; and,

WHEREAS, the accident history for the subject intersection shows that, in a five-year span that ended September 30, 2002, there were 36 reported collisions, three causing fatalities and eight involving pedestrians, constituting an urgency for a traffic signal; and,

WHEREAS, arrangements to install a traffic signal at the subject intersection are being made with the scheduled award of a contract by City Council within the next 30 days; and,

WHEREAS, traffic analysis indicates that multiway stop signs at the subject intersection can improve safety for vehicles and pedestrians; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the installation of stop signs on Bancroft Avenue at 77<sup>th</sup> Avenue is hereby approved.
