RESOLUTION No. 83130 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTEEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO DOLLARS AND EIGHT CENTS (\$13,582.08) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY, TO BE ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA-BERKELEY TRAFFIC SAFETY CENTER, TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CALIFORNIA SEAT BELT COMPLIANCE CAMPAIGN "CLICK IT OR TICKET" MINI-GRANT PROGRAM FOR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR THE PROGRAM PERIODS OF NOVEMBER 15 THROUGH 28, 2010 AND MAY 23 THROUGH JUNE 5, 2011

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in the amount of \$13,582.08 will be awarded by the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, for participation in the 2010 California Seat Belt Compliance Campaign "Click It or Ticket" Mini-Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the California Seat Belt Compliance Campaign is geared toward focusing public attention on seatbelt safety information and enforcement on persons who fail to use seat belts during a 28-day period in November 2010, May and June 2011 in support of the "Click It or Ticket" national mobilization; and

WHEREAS, the California Seat Belt Compliance Campaign is a collaborative effort between the California Highway Patrol, the Office Traffic Safety and local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 78137 C.M.S. dated October 21, 2003, and Resolution No. 79115 C.M.S., dated March 15, 2005, and Resolution No. 79857 C.M.S. dated May 2, 2006, and Resolution No. 80577 C.M.S. dated May 15, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the grant does not cover Central Services Overhead charges in the amount of \$1,852.59 (based on a calculation rate of 13.64% for salary and wages of \$13,582.08), and the Department requests a waiver of said charges; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$13,582.08 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, administered through the University of California-Berkeley Traffic Safety Center for implementation of the 2010 Seat Belt Compliance Campaign and appropriate said funds to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That grant funds shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund (2999), Traffic Administration Division Organization (107510), Traffic Program (PS14), in a Project Account to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Central Services Overhead costs associated with the grant award of \$13,582.08 in the amount of \$1,852.59 (13.64%) are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or his designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, and extend this grant award, except for any increase in the award amount without returning to the City Council; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve said grant agreement as to form and legality and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
