

RESOLUTION NO. 88305 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL (ABC) ALCOHOL POLICING PARTNERSHIP (APP) PROGRAM, AND APPROPRIATE NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$97,500) FOR THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR OF 2020-2021 IMPLEMENTATION OF OPD'S ALCOHOL CONTROL ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL PURPOSE SERVICES FUND TO CONTRIBUTE FOURTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$14,822) TO COVER THE ASSOCIATED CENTRAL SERVICES OVERHEAD (CSO) COSTS.

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed ninety-seven thousand, five hundred dollars (\$97,500) will be received from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), Alcohol Police Partnership (APP) Program for the fiscal year of 2020-2021 implementation of the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project within the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these State of California grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address alcohol-related problems through a comprehensive alcohol beverage control program within the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department's primary goals through the Alcohol Control Enforcement Project is to reduce the illegal sales and possession of alcoholic beverages to minors, prevent and reduce the incidents of loitering at alcoholic beverage establishments, and increase involvement with local community groups by providing a minimum of four community outreach meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Alcohol Police Partnership Program grant period of performance is from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used to cover overtime costs for ABAT's enforcement operations and operational expenses related to the enforcement, outreach, and education activities; and

WHEREAS, the 15.5 percent Central Service Indirect Overhead Costs in the amount of \$14,822 are not allowed by the grantor; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or designee to accept and appropriate a grant award in an amount not to ninety-seven thousand, five hundred dollars (\$97,500) from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Alcohol Police Partnership (APP) Program; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the from the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), Alcohol Police Partnership (APP) grant revenues will be allocated to the State of California Fund (2159); Special Operations Division Org (107710); Project (TBD); Special Operations Program (PS13); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes a contribution of \$14,822 from the general purpose fund to cover the associated central services overhead costs of 15.5 percent which the grant does not cover; and be it

FUTHER RESOLVED: That all contracts issued hereunder shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and copies shall be placed on file in the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the agreement.
